The Yahk-Kingsgate area has a rich history filled with pioneers, lumber, railways and other endeavors. However, most of our archives are not stored in a way that preserves them long term. This makes our archives at risk of loss, and very difficult to share. For example, there are about 5.000 photos that we want to better preserve.

We applied for and were approved for the first phase of our Archive Project. This phase will include the visit of an experienced archivist to provide us with an assessment of our archiving needs and to provide training to those that wish to receive free training on the tools and techniques for storing and digitizing our archive documents.

Training is set to begin in October, with work progressing through the winter months.

- \* Judging will commence Saturday 10 am to 11 am. No one will be allowed in the exhibit area at this time other than designated Judges.



# **Community Contribution** Gardening

### Prepare Your Garden/Beds For Winter

Cleaning up and preparing your garden for the winter is just as important as getting it ready for planting in the spring!

Start by removing all the dead vegetation. Diseases & pests can overwinter if dead plant material is left in. Put any healthy vegetation in your compost pile. Burn or place in the trash any diseased plants.

Add 1-2 inches of finished compost and/or manure to your garden/beds. Then Lightly cover with mulch to help suppress weeds to protect soil. Do not mulch too heavily as this can prevent the soil from freezing properly and killing off pests & diseases.

The fall is a great time to plant garlic once you have prepared the soil. One of the best garlic growing sites that I use is garlicfarm.ca

Gather up all your fallen leaves to use as mulch, these are considered Gardeners Gold. Do not let leaves sit on your lawns as they can rot when they get too wet and ruin your lawn. Put them in your compost if there are too many for your garden/beds.

There is much more information about preparing for the winter but these basics will make a difference you will appreciate. Enjoy the nice crisp fall air as you pamper your gardens!!
